



Application Guidelines for **RETURNING** StreamTeam Interns

Returning StreamTeam Interns have the opportunity to send in a new application packet (available on the HCSEG website) or they may update what is on file from last year. Applicants may want to send in a new essay to make improvements or updates, especially if their career path has changed.

Minimum updates to the application packet includes:

- 1) A **cover letter** with the applicant's contact information and brief answers to at least three of the following questions (please don't exceed 1 ½ pages):
 - a. Why would you make a good StreamTeam Intern? What skills do you have to offer the team this year?
 - b. What have you enjoyed about being a part of the StreamTeam internship and are there any improvements you would like to make or see made to the program this year?
 - c. Describe something you have learned or gained from being a StreamTeam Intern.
 - d. How has this opportunity helped your school or career goals? Have these goals changed or been refined since last year?
 - e. Have there been any opportunities, experiences or projects you have encountered or been a part of that have inspired your career goals?

- 2) An updated transcript (last Spring to present).

Other materials which the applicant should have sent in last year include:

- *Past high school and college transcripts*
- *An essay conveying the link between the applicant, intended career path, and Wild Salmon*
- *A letter of acceptance from a college or university*
- *A letter of reference*
